SCHOLARSHIP FUND

At the 1953 reunion the classes by contributions increased the fund by \$6,000, which, with income from investments, makes the total trust fund as of December 31, 1953, \$36,105.34.

The award is paid from income of the Trust Investments.

At a meeting of the Scholarship Committee held January 26, 1954, consideration was given to recommending to the Executive Committee for ratification, to increase the award from \$150.00 to \$200.00 each year for four years, and to create a second award for two years, of \$75.00 each year, with the thought that in the future, classes by contributions would be able to increase the second award at different times.
