WELCOME!

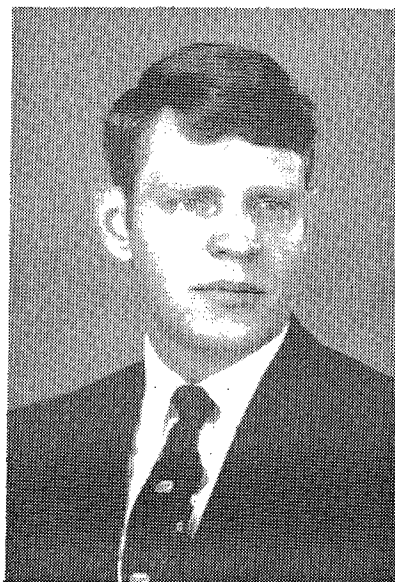
We gather to renew friendships, refresh memories, and re-establish our ties to our high school years. We welcome you and thank you for your participation.

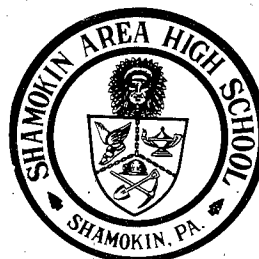
